A one day interactive In Service education was conducted by Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing 2<sup>nd</sup> year under the guidance of Nursing Tutor, Rufaida college of Nursing on 24<sup>th</sup> of November 2021 on the topic “Needle stick injury” and the recipients were 35 staff nurses in different wards.

Needlestick injuries are wounds caused by needles that accidentally puncture the skin. Needlestick injuries are a hazard for people who work with hypodermic syringes and other needle equipment. These injuries can occur at any time when people use, disassemble, or dispose the needles. This is the major problems who are working in hospital. The prevalence of needle stick injury is accounts for 73.2%

A total of 29 students participated in this In Service education programme and 35 staff nurses attended the programme.

The programme was inaugurated by Ms. Annamma John, CNS Officer Batra Hospital and Medical Research Centre and Ms. Suchanda Bhattacharya, Nursing Tutor Rufaida College Of Nursing. Ms. Srishti Bajaj hosted the programme. The pre-test was taken before initiating the In Service education programme followed by health talk, post-test and feedback. A total of 7 students gave the health talk that included the introduction of needle stick injury, what is the definition of needle stick injury, What is the incidence rate of needle stick injury, What are the causes of needle stick injury, who are at risk of needle stick injury, how to prevent the needle stick injury, what are the nurse's role to prevent needle stick injury, what is the protocol to be followed while having needle stick injury according to different sector.

Nursing Tutor elaborated the importance of following the protocol while meeting with needle stick injury which made it very easy to understand for the staff nurses.

The valedictory session of the programme commenced with the vote of thanks by Ms. Srishti Bajaj. Feedback was obtained from the recipients at the end through online form.
